# **Submission of proposals**

Authors are invited to register and submit a abstract\* (2 500 characters at most) no later than the 22<sup>nd</sup> of November 2019, via the conference website: <a href="https://aic2020rennes.sciencesconf.org">https://aic2020rennes.sciencesconf.org</a> Participants may submit one proposal as first author only.

# Selection of proposals, review & publication

Authors will be notified of their abstract approval on the 22nd of December 2019. The first author will then submit the extended abstract\* (4 to 6 pages maximum) before the 14<sup>th</sup> of February 2020, which will go through a review process.

The final text, approved by the scientific committee, will be **published in the Proceedings** of the symposium only on payment of the registration fees of the first author.

\*Guidelines for authors (abstract and extended abstract) will be provided on the conference website (Opening in September).
